A Nobel Diploma

The design of each diploma is decided by the respective prize-awarding bodies.

A Nobel Medal

Each Nobel Medal, weighing 175-185 g, is made in 18 carat green gold, plated with 24 carat gold.

Prize money

The Nobel Prize amount for 2015 is set at about USD 970,000.
